THE AMERICAN FRIEND--widely considered the major revelation of the 1977 Cannes and New York Film Festivals--established Wim Wenders with Fassbinder and Herzog in the very first rank of the remarkably resurgent German cinema. Based on Patricia Highsmith's thriller Ripley's Game, the baroquely complex storyline centers on an ordinary Hamburg artist (Bruno Ganz) employed as an assassin by a French gangster through the manipulation of a mysterious American. The film raises Wenders' themes of rootlessness and the tenuousness of personality to a global level, detailing a homogenized post-war world in which cities, languages, and cultures blur into each other with an ease that is both exhilarating and frightening.

Reminiscent of Chekhov in its tidy insights, relentless probing and summation of people's lives, THE THEME follows a famous playwright, Kim Yesenin, as he attempts to rejuvenate his talent by leaving Moscow for the frozen solitude offered by a remote Russian village. Here, in a house belonging to a woman teacher with a love of literature, Yesenin decides to work on his new play. But he is diverted by the people he meets, especially the young and beautiful Sasha, who points out to him that he has sacrificed his creativity to fame and fortune. Winner of the Golden Bear at the 1987 Berlin Film Festival this films value and power lies in the way it examines with pristine complexity the role and responsibility of the artist in contemporary Soviet society.

In THE FAMILY, Ettore Scola weaves a gentle domestic tale chronicling four generations of an Italian middle-class family. The film begins in 1906 and covers the next eighty years without ever leaving the family's Rome apartment. The film's narrator is Carlo and the narrative follows his story from childhood into old age. Eccentric aunts, uncles gone astray, and impertinent children, all people the corridors of the protagonist's genealogy. It is a family of artists and a family of spinsters and fools--it is a family like any other family. Drama is found in the everyday and the wonderful candor with which the characters reveal themselves make this an endearing and affectionate film.

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STATE OF SIEGE





Piece by piece, revolutionaries uncover the discreetly concealed function of the "special advisor" in their country, and a gripping portrait of the U.S. role in Latin America takes shape.

A true epic, MAN OF MARBLE contains reflections on propaganda and art, on the relationship of the working class to the intelligentsia, presented with a fast-moving urgency that belies the film's monumental length and scope.

Richard Burton and Elizabeth Taylor, Hollywood's on-again, off-again couple, play Shakespeare's battling couple, Katharina and Petruchio in this ebullient Zeffirelli production. Burton is in rare form as the scoundrel Petruchio as he forces the rapier-tongued Katharina to marry him against her will and then turns his back on her. TAMING OF THE SHREW is a contemporary production for all Renaissance wit and opulence. The ending is verbal Shakespeare, but visually feminist. Petruchio wins his bet that he has tamed Kate, and while she instructs her obstreperous sisters on the virtues of obedience to one's husband, the audience knows full well that Petruchio and Kate are a matched pair of equals within the marriage.





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KING LEAR

Shakespeare's monumental tragedy has been adapted for the screen for the first time since the 1916 silent film version. Peter Brook, one of the great stage directors of our time and the man behind the film version of LORD OF THE FLIES, has directed Paul Scofield (the Oscar winning star of A MAN FOR ALL SEASONS) in the leading role. Scofield and distinguished actress Irene Worth (Goneril) are repeating the roles they performed in the Royal Shakespeare Company's production in 1962, also directed by Brook. The powerful poetic drama of an aging king reapportioning his kingdom among his three daughters was magnificently photographed on the Jutland Peninsula, Denmark.

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


RAN is Akira Kurosawa's twenty-seventh film, the culmination of an extraordinary career. In its epic scale, stylistic grandeur and tragic contemplation of human destiny, RAN brings together the great themes and spectacular images of the seventy-five-year-old director's life work.

RAN, which translates as "chaos" or "turmoil", is Kurosawa's meditation on Shakespeare's <u>King Lear</u> crossed with the history of Japan's 16th-century Civil Wars and the legend of Mori, a feudal warlord with three good sons. The tale of the three arrows, unbreakable when sheathed together, is Mori's famous illustration of filial loyalty and family strength in unity. RAN grew out of the question Kurosawa posed himself: what if Mori's sons had not been loyal? What if the three arrows were broken? The answer is RAN, <u>King Lear</u> imbued with Japanese history and philosophy and deeply personal echoes of Akira Kurosawa himself.

Andrei Tarkovsky's

ANDREI RUBLEV

Considered by many critics to be the most important Russian film of the past 20 years, ANDREI RUBLEV is based on the life of fifteenth century Russian monk and icon painter, Andrei Rublev, and follows his experiences in a Russia ravaged by Tartar invaders. Rublev is shown during various times of his life, as the period is vividly recreated in all its violence. In order to save a peasant girl from rape, Rublev is forced to kill and thereupon vows never to paint or speak again. The monk's creative flame is rekindled in a remarkable scene involving the casting of a giant bell by a young boy and the final reel bursts into color as Rublev returns to icon painting again.

ANDREI RUBLEV is that very rare hybrid, an epic that is totally personal, expressing the feelings of an artist in conflict with his society.

Fassbinder's treatment of Theodor Fontane's 19th-century classic is both an extremely faithful adaptation of the novel and a subtle manipulation of its structure. Effi Briest, a vivacious mixture of anticonformity and mediocrity, is married when very young to a much older Prussian diplomat. Carried away to a remote Baltic port, she drifts into a brief, passionless affair, the full effects of which are felt only six years later, in a chilling manifestation of the Prussian code.



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WERTHER is a loose interpretation of the characters described by Johanne W. Goethe. Our leading character is no longer that gentleman of impeccable dress and mannerly behavior. He is now a young teacher who has just arrived to a northern village to teach Greek in a private school. He rides to class on a bicycle, is a nature lover, a devoted educator, and a person who seems to be constantly searching in the world surrounding him; always at odds with rules and established modes of behavior.

The headmaster of the school asks him to take on a private class with a young boy having problems. He accepts the offer and, as a consequence, meets the boy's mother, Carlotta, who is separated from her husband.
