A moving and undeniably brilliant film by the talented Tran Anh Hung, set in 1951 and centered on a young woman who becomes a servant for a turbulent family. The film follows in exquisitely lyrical detail the quiet beauty and stoically accepted hardships of her life as, ten years later, she starts a love affair with her next employer. Shot enitirely on a Paris soundstage, this, says critic Roger Ebert, "is a film to cherish."



This Oscar-nominated documentary examines the long-term effects of war from the perspective of women, both Vietnamese and American, who lost their husbands during the Vietnam War. Director Barbara Sonneborn, whose own husband was killed, has crafted a beautiful and powerfully resonant film.
