

TOKYO MONOGATARI

Directed by Yasujiro Ozu

The enormous popular response to a twenty-year old Japanese film called Tokyo Story when it was first released here in 1972 marks one of the best noteworthy filmgoing phenomena of recent years. Yasujiro Ozu's quietly overpowering masterpiece tells a deceptively simple tale of an elderly couple who journey to Tokyo, where they are received less than enthusiastically by their grown-up children; then generational conflicts are stilled-momentarily-by death. Ozu unfolds his story with warmth and quiet emotion, but at the heart of his Old World civility is a vision of alienation in the modern world as powerful as any by Antonioni and Bergman. Ozu's unique style—a subtle interplay of rhythm, detail, and restraint—has become legendary; there is no better introduction to his method than Tokyo Story.
