12RUSSIAN | 160 MIN | 2007 | NIKITA MIKHALKOV

12 jurors must decide the fate of a Chechen teenager charged with murdering his stepfather. As they deliberate, the accused revisits his tragic journey through war in a series of flashbacks. An Oscar-nominated remake of 12 Angry Men, Mikhalkov's film looks at fear, trust and the triumph of human nature.

HOWL'S MOVING CASTLE


JAPANESE | 119 MIN | 2004 | HAYAO MIYAZAKI

Dr. Isak Borg, an aging doctor and professor, decides to take the daylong drive from Stockholm to Lund to accept an honorary degree. Along the way, he encounters many stops that make him reminisce about his past. Borg is forced to confront a life marked by coldness and the emptiness of his existence.
