THE LAST OF THE MOHICANS

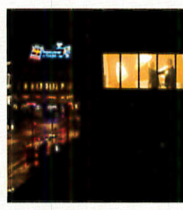

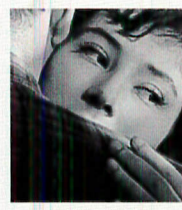

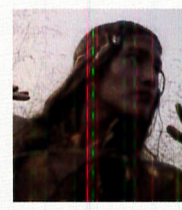

THE CRANES ARE FLYING

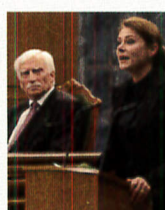

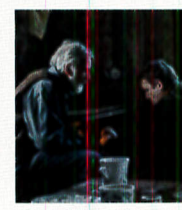
